Ohio is **RANKED NO. 2 IN THE NATION** for egg production.

Ohio has MORE THAN 30 MILLION laying hens.

Ohio produces more than 10 BILLION EGGS per year and provides as much as \$3.2 BILLION in support to the state's economy.

Ohio egg production is responsible for the creation of **14,438 JOBS** and **\$559 MILLION** in annual earnings.







- The Ohio Egg Quality Assurance Program (OEQAP) is a voluntary program that was created to minimize the risk of Salmonella Enteritidis (SE) in eggs, and is a cooperative effort between egg producers and farmers, the Ohio Poultry Association and the Ohio Department of Agriculture.
- Ohio's egg farms follow FDA's Federal Egg Safety Rule, which ensures eggs are safe and free from Salmonella and other foodborne bacteria.
- Ohio egg farmers participate in the United Egg Producers Certified animal care program.
 The guidelines place top priority on the comfort, health and safety of the chickens and include increased space per hen.
