These programs include general bird health and welfare programs, as well as the National Poultry Improvement Plan (Official State Agency - Ohio) and egg quality assurance programs. OPA is also looking to develop new programming for smaller, commercial flocks in Ohio.

Qualifications, Skills, Abilities and Personal Characteristics: Minimum Bachelor of Science in Animal Sciences or Poultry Science, or equivalent experience. It is recommended the applicant have a working knowledge of the NPPI and general poultry industry.
